NOTES: The Board would like to seek Water Sector 2nd round funding for the replacement of the water meter system currently in use due to availability and warranty issued; the Board wishes to request the remainder of the ARP funds be used to correct voltage fluctuation issues at the well that cause issues during winter storms, otherwise the Board will proceed with the RR crossing connection; and the Board considered a 15% water rate increase for all categories of customers. The rate increase will be presented to USDA for review and approval prior to the Board's vote.
